Daily Efforts with Eternal Impact

Lately, I have been thinking with great admiration about the faithfulness of the people who invest in the students at Emanuel University. Some of the investors dedicate their entire lives to spending time face to face with the students and mentoring them. Others dedicate their financial resources for years to professionally and spiritually train our students to become God's ambassadors in society. Both prove what in Christian language is called "faithfulness" or "consistency."

Let's not become discouraged in doing good, for in due time we will reap, if we do not become weary (Galatians 6:9). God's Word urges us to live a life of consistency. Consistency involves discovering the important things, those with a great purpose, and making a **daily effort** to achieve them. These cannot be achieved through intense action, just as an athlete cannot excel if he trains for 10 hours every two months. But, if he trains daily, he will get the desired results.

Many of us accept these things on a theoretical level, but this is not the case in practice most of the time. Thomas Edison said that "the three great essentials to achieve anything worthwhile are, first, hard work; second, **perseverance**; third, common sense." The reason we are not consistent is that we have a short-term mentality.

And yet, if you are a consistent person, what's next?

The apostle Paul answers: *do not become discouraged in doing good*. Once we start on the path of consistency, fatigue, boredom, even obstacles can appear. Daniel was a faithful man in good times and hard times: *Now when Daniel learned that the document was signed, he entered his house (and in his roof chamber he had windows open toward Jerusalem); and he continued kneeling on his knees three times a day, praying and offering praise before his God, <i>just as he had been doing previously* (Daniel 6:10). Why is it that God's people have the power to remain faithful to him in troubled times? Because they know their daily efforts have an **eternal impact**.

Thank you, dear partners, for the consistency you have shown in supporting Emanuel University for months or years! We pray that God will reward your hard work and help us to enjoy the result of service in this life and eternity!


Some tips for each of our subscribers:

Emanuel University means a lot to me. It was the place where God


