God is for us

Many people believe and put their trust in luck, fate, or karma; they also try to get these "forces" on their side to work for them in fulfilling the plans they have made and in manipulating the circumstances they depend on. This is a baseless belief in a vague force. For a Christian, things are completely different. He knows that it's not a force, an idea, or a man that is on his side, but the true God, the One who wisely rules the entire world. **Still, what does it**

Romans 8:31 captures the glorious reality of the covenant relationship that God initiated with man. It is a penetrating, solid theological statement, a basis for the Christian's hope for this life and for the one to come. The beginning reiterates the majesty of the true God and that is because Paul wants his readers to constantly keep in mind the glorious image of the God of Scripture as they go through the lines. *If God is for us*... The God who commands and whose words come into being, the God who designed our bodies and sustains our lives, the God whose voice makes the nations stagger and the earth tremble, that God is for us! The same God who called Abraham, who parted the Red Sea, who led the people of Israel in the wilderness and who delivered people like Joseph, David and Daniel is for us! The God who made Himself known through miracles, through His people and also through His Son at the right time, He is for us! The God who raised Jesus from the dead is for us! What a glorious truth! Paul's logic is simple: If God is who He says He is, if Scripture is true, and if this God is for us, then who can stand against us?

Far from being a mere theological statement, this verse captures the heart of the doctrine of the adoption. Although our sins once set God against us, now, as children of the Father, God is on our side – He is for us. This means that we are accepted, but not in the sense of being tolerated by Him; we are much more than that, we are loved! The reality of adoption is this: God is for us. In the same way that a father is for his family – he loves, cares for, defends and represents them –, God is for us! Just as the father of a family bound himself to it by love and covenant, in the same way God bound himself to us. **Who will be against us?**

The idea continues in the following verses of Romans 8: "Who will separate us from the love of Christ? *Will* tribulation, or trouble, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword? Just as it is written: 'For Your sake we are killed all day long; we were regarded as sheep to be slaughtered.' But in all these things we overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us. For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus, our Lord." **Because** *God is for us...*

Along with apostle Paul, we are also fully convinced that God, through Jesus Christ, is on our side, that our sins no longer put a wall of separation between us and Him and that we have free entrance to the One who loves us!
